On 10/29/2024, deputies responded to a report of an assault involving a male suspect who spit on a woman while she was walking her dog. The responding deputies located the male suspect nearby. While attempting to detain the suspect for the assault, the suspect fled on foot causing one deputy to fall and be injured. The deputies pursued the suspect to a nearby marsh area where he hid. Additional deputies arrived and searched the area for the suspect. Ultimately, they located the suspect hiding. Due to the suspects' previous resistance and attempt to flee which caused injury to a deputy, two of the deputies drew their department issued CEWs, activated them and pointed the CEWs at the suspect while giving him verbal commands. The suspect complied with their commands at the display of the weapons and was taken into custody without further incident. He was booked on the charges of 69 PC and 242 PC.

On 12/2/2024, MCSO Detectives were conducting an investigation in Mill Valley when their attention was drawn to several Mill Valley Police vehicles driving nearby with their emergency lights activated. They then received information via radio to be on the lookout for a burglary suspect fleeing from law enforcement. One of the detectives located the suspect matching the

description, running away and attempting to gain access to another vehicle. The detective pursued the suspect on foot, unholstered his department issued CEW, activated it and pointed it at the suspect. The suspect immediately complied with the detective's commands to stop. The suspect was taken into custody by Mill Valley Police Department and arrested for multiple felonies.

On 12/3/2024, after extensive investigation and electronic search warrants, detectives developed probable cause to arrest an adult male suspect for 211 PC (Robbery), 664 211 PC (Attempted Robbery) and additional weapon charges.

Detectives located the suspect in a vehicle in a Marin County shopping center. Nearby uniformed officers conducted a traffic stop on the vehicle. Due to the severity of the crimes, the criminal history of the suspect, and because the suspect was known to carry firearms, deputies drew their department firearms and CEWs and pointed them at the suspect. One detective provided commands to which the suspect complied and was taken into custody without incident. The suspect was booked into the Marin County Jail for the above listed charges.
